

## **ACT Prep On-line Little Rock Christian Academy**

The on-line prep course used in Little Rock Christian Academy's ACT prep courses is available to all LRCA students. This sixty-hour course can be used at home for any age student to prepare for the ACT exam. Students have access twenty-four hours a day and 365 days a year. LRCA receives reports and can monitor a student's progress.

To use the "on-line" prep course, do this:

1. Go to [www.bridges.com](http://www.bridges.com).
2. Create a new portfolio using these:
  - Site ID: 1220388
  - Password: A2r2r3X8
3. Write down your personal account name and password.
4. Only create one account per student. Our site license is limited.

After you have created an account, set aside 30-45 minutes to do the diagnostic test called "Brain Scan." This test will help create your individual curriculum, designed for each individual's needs.

After doing the Brain Scan, you can follow the "Smart Curriculum" which is designed individually. It will focus on your areas of need. Or, you can use any of the resources available in the Complete Library.

"Your Entire Curriculum" (Smart Curriculum) and "Complete Library" consist of these:

- Practorial—essentially, how to "play the game" of the ACT. If your time is limited, do these first. They focus on the ACT, types of questions, techniques, etc.
- Micro-Course—courses on specific content areas related to Mathematics, English, Reading, Science, and Writing.
- Lab—Vocabulary review.
- Practice Test—short tests in subject areas to practice.
- Full Test—two complete ACT tests.

If you don't have a lot of time, do the Practorials, a complete test, and Micro-courses that address your weaker areas.

You are encouraged to obtain a free ACT booklet from the guidance office or on-line at [ACT.org](http://ACT.org) and read through it, as well. This booklet published by ACT reiterates basics to remember and rules for the test.
