

**Arkansas Youth Shooting Sports Program
Little Rock Christian Academy Trap Team
Kick-off Meeting
Held - December 12, 2011**

Program

The Arkansas Youth Shooting Sports Program (AYSSP) is focused on providing a fun, safe environment for participating in shooting sports and reconnecting youth with the joy of being outdoors. The AYSSP will raise awareness of conservation related sports, promote safety and responsibility, and raise self-esteem. The AYSSP is a program operated by the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission (AGFC).

Season

The AYSSP season begins February 1 and ends on July 31 each year.

Registration

All participants must complete a Student / Athlete Participant Form and Participant's Waiver of Liability Release and Assumption of Risk form. All student / athletes must complete Hunter's Education training and provide a Hunter's Education number to complete registration. The head coach for the Senior Division team is John Crabtree. The head coach for the Junior Division team is Lanny Lancaster. The team name is the Little Rock Christian Academy Warriors. Forms will be filed with the AGFC by the head coaches. Forms must be provided to head coach by January 27, 2011.

Division

The Senior Division is comprised of participants currently enrolled in grades 9-12. The Junior Division is comprised of participants currently enrolled in grades 6-8.

Adult Supervision

All team members should have an adult present at all practices and competitions. Team members may have a parent, grandparent, aunt, uncle or legal guardian at each event.

Team Composition

The team will be comprised of members from Little Rock Christian Academy (LRCA). Teams are comprised of five member squads. There is no upper limit on the number of members that can be registered per team.

Regular Practices

Practice will be held at Blue Rock Gun Club. More information regarding the location and dates will be provided in future team communication.

Eye and Ear Protection

All AYSSP participants and coaches must wear appropriate eye and ear protection during all practices and competitions while standing within the competition field

Foot Protection

All competitors must wear closed-toe footwear while on the competition field. The use of toe pads or the resting of firearms barrels on any part of the foot is strictly prohibited.

Shotguns

Only shotguns in a safe and serviceable condition with bore sizes of 12 or 20 gauges are allowed. Shotguns with release triggers are prohibited.

Ammunition

A limited amount of ammunition is provided through an AYSSP grant.
