

LRCA Middle School Dress Code

LRCA student dress is expected to be modest and in keeping with Christian principles. "Modest" means that clothing is loose fitting and covers the body according to expectations below. Administration has authority to interpret and enforce dress code expectations. Violation of any portion of the dress code may result in disciplinary action, with or without warning. LRCA reserves the right to alter or adjust these expectations at any time.

Our Expectations

SHIRTS:

- Knit polo style shirt, long or short sleeve, any solid color
- Button down collared dress shirt, long or short sleeve, any solid color (shirt must be buttoned and not worn as a jacket)
- Logos:
 - o Manufacturer logos must be smaller than one square inch.
 - All LRCA logo sizes are approved.

HOODIES & SWEATSHIRTS (MUST BE WORN OVER A UNIFORM SHIRT):

• ONLY LRCA or House hoodies, hooded jackets, and sweatshirts are approved.

• Knitted sweaters may be worn if they are a solid color.

OUTERWEAR (MUST BE WORN OVER A UNIFORM SHIRT):

- Jackets and coats are to be worn outside the building ONLY.
- Winter hats, gloves, and scarves must be worn outside the building ONLY.

PANTS:

- Blue jeans with neutral stitching without embellishments
- Corduroy, twill/cotton blend flat or pleated front in navy or khaki (stone or tan)
- Must be hemmed, no holes or frays; no baggy or sagging pants and must fit at the waist
- No stretch pants, form fitting pants, yoga pants, leggings, athletic wear, sleeping pants, scrubs or similar wear

SHORTS:

- Blue washed hemmed denim, navy or khaki (tan or stone)
- No more than 2" above the knee
- No frayed, baggy or sagging shorts and must fit at the waist

SKIRTS/SKORTS (LADIES ONLY):

- Knee length to 2 inches above the top of knee (front and back)
- Skirts and skorts must be navy or khaki (tan or stone)
- Shorts must be worn under skirts and not seen below the hem line.
- If leggings, or tights are worn, they should be solid navy or white.

FOOTWEAR:

- Shoes must be closed toe, any style and color.
- Socks, any style and color, must be worn at all times.
- Slippers or house shoes are not permitted.

HAIR:

- Off the collar and out of the eyes
- Natural colors only
- Clean and neat
- No pony tails or tied hair for gentlemen
- Distracting styles are not permitted (including mohawks or hair attachments)
- No facial hair
- No sideburns lower than the ear

OTHER:

- No head covering of any type including hats, visors and hoods
- No visible tattoos or body piercings
- No lettering or messaging on clothing
- No long chains or ear piercings for gentlemen
- No more than two earrings per ear for ladies (small hoops or studs only)
- Ladies are permitted to wear minimal make-up.

REQUIRED MIDDLE SCHOOL T-SHIRT:

- Gray middle school t-shirt available in the Warrior Store
- MS t-shirt is required for field trips and other designated days.

T-SHIRT TUESDAY:

 Required gray middle school t-shirt or house shirt may be worn instead of regular uniform shirt.

WARRIOR WEAR FRIDAY:

^{*}Certain ethnic distinctions will be considered when in line with a student's heritage.

Any LRCA t-shirt or house shirt may be worn instead of regular uniform shirt.
Students may choose to wear a jersey over a Warrior t-shirt or regular uniform shirt.

DRESS CODE VIOLATION

• Students will be reminded throughout the year the required dress code. Students may be required to obtain a change of clothes before returning to class and/or may receive a disciplinary consequence.
